

Conditions of Sales

1. DEFINITIONS

- ii The Supplier is EUROFIT HARDWARES PTY LTD (ACN 106 455 369).
- iii The Customer is the party or any person acting on behalf of and with the authority of the Customer that the Order is provided for.
- iv The Guarantor is the person(s), or entity, who agrees to be liable for the debts of the Customer.
- v The Order is any request for the provision of Goods and/or Services by the Customer with the Supplier which has been accepted by the Supplier.
- vi The Goods are the products and/or components provided by the Supplier.
- vii The Price is the amount invoiced for Goods supplied or Services provided.
- viii Indirect, Special or Consequential loss or damage includes i) any loss of income profit or business; ii) any loss of good will or reputation; iii) any loss of value of intellectual property.
- ix Invoices include invoices for Goods supplied or Services provided, or both.

2. GENERAL

- i. These Terms and Conditions together with the supplier are written quotation and the Suppliers Credit Application Form forms this Agreement.
- ii. Any Order requested by the Customer is deemed to be an Order incorporating these Terms and Conditions notwithstanding any inconsistencies which may be introduced in the Customer Order or acceptance unless expressly agreed to by the Supplier in writing. In the event that an inconsistency exists and/or arises it is acknowledged between the parties that these Terms and Conditions will prevail.
- iii. The Terms and Conditions are binding on the Customer, his heirs, assignees, executors, trustees and where applicable, any liquidator, receiver or administrator.
- iv. In these Terms and Conditions, the singular shall include the plural, the masculine shall include feminine and neuter and words importing persons shall apply to corporations.
- v. Where more than one Customer completes this Agreement each shall be liable jointly and severally.
- vi. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions shall be invalid, void, illegal or unenforceable the validity, existence, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected, prejudiced or impaired and the offending provision shall be deemed as severed from these Terms and Conditions.
- vii. The Supplier may license or sub-contract all or any part of its rights and obligations without the Customers consent.
- viii. The failure by the Supplier to enforce any provision of these Terms and Conditions shall not be treated as a waiver of that provision, nor shall it affect the Suppliers right to subsequently enforce that provision.
- ix. The Customer acknowledges that the Supplier may use these Terms and Conditions on its website and that it may provide notice to the Customer of any amendments. In this event, the Terms and Conditions on the Suppliers website shall apply to any future dealings between the parties and the Customer is deemed to have notice of any such Terms and Conditions and/or amendments.
- x. These Terms and Conditions must be read in conjunction with the Suppliers Credit Application Form.

3. PLACEMENT OF ORDERS

- i. Orders placed by the Customer with the Supplier will be considered valid when placed the Order by telephone, fax, email and/or face-to-face.
- ii. Customers must provide the Supplier with a Purchase Order before any Goods or Services are provided.
- iii. Any written Quotation given by the Supplier shall expire thirty (30) days after the date of the written quotation.
- iv. All prices are based on taxes and statutory charges current at the time of the Quotation. Should these vary during the period from the date of the Quotation to the date of the invoice, the difference will become the responsibility of the Customer and the Customer will be invoiced for the extra charge by the Supplier.

4. PRICE

- i. At the Suppliers sole discretion the Price shall be either:
- ii. As detailed on invoices provided by the Supplier to the Customer in respect of Goods supplied; or the suppliers quoted price as for the Order (subject to clause iii).
- iii. The Supplier reserves the right to change the Price in the event of a variation to the Suppliers Order.

5. SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF GOODS

- i. The Supplier reserves their right to: a) Decline requests for any Goods requested by the Customer; b) Cancel or postpone the delivery of Goods at their discretion.
- ii. Delivery of the Goods shall be deemed to be complete when the Goods are collected by the Customer or are delivered to the Customer or to the carrier as nominated by the Supplier and/or Customer.
- iii. Goods shall be delivered to the address specified in the Credit Application unless otherwise agreed to in writing between the parties.
- iv. If the Customer fails to make all arrangements necessary to take delivery of the Goods the Customer shall, at the discretion of the Supplier, be liable for a \$33.00 Non Delivery Fee and the Supplier shall be entitled, also at its discretion, to charge a reasonable fee for redelivery and storage.
- v. Unless specified by the Supplier to the contrary in the Order, the Supplier does not warrant that it will be capable of providing the Goods at specific times requested by the Customer during the term of this Agreement.
- vi. Subject to otherwise complying with its obligations under this Agreement, the Supplier shall exercise its independent discretion as to its most appropriate and effective manner of providing the Goods and of satisfying the Customers expectations of those Goods.
- vii. The Supplier will not be liable for any loss or damage of any kind whatsoever in the event that it is not able to comply with the Customers request for a delivery at a particular time.
- viii. The Customer acknowledges and agrees that it will not make any claim against the Supplier for any loss or damage as a result of late delivery.
- ix. Nothing in the above clause shall effect the Supplier's right to exercise its own judgment and to utilise its skills as it considers most appropriate in order to achieve compliance with the said resolutions, regulations and directions or otherwise with its obligations under this Agreement.
- x. The Supplier may agree to provide, on request from the Customer, additional Goods not included or specifically excluded in the Quotation/Order. In this event, the Supplier shall be entitled to make an additional charge. Additional Goods includes, but is not limited to, alterations, amendments, and any additional visits by the Supplier after provision of the Goods at the request of the Customer.

6. CLAIMS

- i. Unless the Customer notifies the Supplier in writing of its claim within 14 days of receipt of the Goods, the Customer will be deemed to have accepted the Goods as being in accordance with the order.
- ii. Goods cut to length, Goods especially made and Goods procured to the Customers instructions are not eligible for return.

7. PAYMENT AND CREDIT POLICY

- i. Any reference to Customer shall include all Customers, unless it refers to a specific group of Customers.
- ii. A Customer who is not approved as an account customer must make full payment to the Supplier before delivery of the Goods.
- iii. A Customer who is approved as an account customer must make full payment to the Supplier within fourteen (14) days from the end of the month in which the invoice is issued.
- iv. Credit will only be granted at the sole discretion of the Supplier and upon submission of a completed Credit Application Form.
- v. Any credit granted may be revised by the Supplier at any time and at its discretion.

vi. The Supplier reserves the right to withdraw any credit facility upon any breach by the Customer of these Terms of Conditions or upon the Customer ceasing to trade and/or being subject to any legal proceedings and/or the Customer committing an act of insolvency.

- vii. An act of insolvency includes: a) The Customer is dissolved, wound up or placed into bankruptcy or an Order is made by a Court or a resolution is passed or the Customer gives notice of its intention that it be dissolved, wound up or placed into bankruptcy; b) A Liquidator, provisional Liquidator or Trustee in bankruptcy is appointed in respect of the Customer or any property of the Customer; c) An Application is made to a Court for an Order that the Customer be dissolved, wound up or placed into bankruptcy or a Liquidator, provisional Liquidator or Trustee in bankruptcy be appointed in respect of the Customer or any property of the Customer and the Application is not withdrawn or discharged within 14 Days from the Customer becoming aware of receiving notice of the Application; d) A Controlling is appointed in respect of the Customer or any property of the Customer or takes possession or gains control of any property of the Customer; e) Except to reconstruct or amalgamate while solvent, the Customer enters into, or resolves to enter into, a scheme of arrangement, administration, deed of company arrangement or composition with, or assignment for the benefit of, all or any class of its creditors, or it proposes a reorganization, moratorium or other administration involving any of them; f) The Company is (or states that it is) insolvent or insolvent under administration; g) As a result of the operation of Section 459P(1) of the *Corporations Act 2001 (CW)*, the Company is taken to have failed to comply with a statutory demand; h) Execution or other process issued on a judgment, decree of Order of a Court in favour of a creditor against the Customer, or another party authorised to be sued as nominal Defendant on behalf of the Customer, is returned wholly or partly unsatisfied, or the Customer makes a statement from which it may be reasonably deduced that such an event has occurred; i) The Customer takes any step to obtain protection or is granted protection from its creditors under any applicable legislation; j) Anything analogous or having a substantially similar effect to any of the events specified above happens under the law of any applicable jurisdiction.
- viii. The Customer agrees that upon such withdrawal, any and all monies owing on the account shall become immediately due and payable.

8. GOODS AND SERVICES TAX

- i. GST refers to Goods and Services tax under the *Goods and Services Act 1999 (GST Act)* and terms used herein have the meanings contained within the *GST Act*.
- ii. It is agreed between the Customer and the Supplier that the consideration for the Supplier expressed in this Agreement is exclusive of the Suppliers liability of GST.
- iii. On sale: a) The Customer will pay to the Supplier, in addition to the total purchase Price, the amount payable by the Supplier of GST on the taxable supply made by the Supplier under this Agreement; b) The Supplier shall deliver to the Customer a Tax Invoice for the supply in a form which complies with the *GST Act* and Regulations.

9. DISHONOUR OF CHEQUE

- i. If any cheque issued by the Customer or by any third party in payment of the Price is dishonoured: a) The Supplier may refuse to supply any further Goods until satisfactory payment is received in full, including bank fees and charges; b) The Supplier is entitled to treat the dishonour of the Customers cheque as a repudiation of this Agreement and to elect between terminating this Agreement or affirming this Agreement, and in each case claiming and recovering compensation for loss or damage suffered from the Customer.
- ii. The Customer may be liable for a dishonoured cheque fee of \$40.00.

10. DEFAULT, SECURITY AND CHARGE

- i. Without prejudice to any other rights of the Supplier, the Customer may be charged account keeping fees of \$20.00 monthly on any payment in arrears.
- ii. If the Supplier does not receive the Outstanding Balance for the Goods or Services on or before the Default Date, the Supplier may, without prejudice to any other remedy it may have, forward the Customers outstanding account to a debt collection agency for further action. The Customer acknowledges and agrees that: a) After the Default Date, the Outstanding Balance shall include, but not limited to, all applicable fees and charges under this Agreement;
- iii. In the event of the Customer being in default of the obligation to pay and the overdue account is then referred to a debt collection agency, or law firm for collection the commission payable and legal costs incurred on an indemnity basis shall be added to the amount outstanding and form part of the debt and in the event where the collection agency charges commission on a contingency basis the commission which would be charged if it achieved 100% recovery shall be added to the debt and the total shall be treated as a liquidated sum.

11. RISK AND LIABILITY

- i. The Customer will ensure when placing Orders that there is sufficient information to enable the Supplier to execute the Order.
- ii. The Supplier takes no responsibility if the specifications are wrong or inaccurate and the Customer will be liable for the expenses incurred by the Supplier for any work required to rectify the Order.
- iii. The Customer is responsible for ensuring that the Supplier is made aware of any special requirements pertaining to the Order and that the Supplier relies upon the integrity of the information supplied to it.
- iv. The Supplier takes no responsibility and will not be liable for any damages or costs resulting in the Goods being faulty as a consequence of insufficient information provided by the Customer.
- v. The Supplier takes no responsibility for representations made in relation to the Goods or any delay in the delivery of the Goods made by a third party or third party manufacturer.
- vi. The Customer acknowledges that the Supplier shall not be liable for and the Customer releases the Supplier from: a) any claims in respect of faulty or defective design of any Goods supplied; b) physical or financial injury, loss or damage or damage of any kind arising out of supply, layout, assembly, installation or operation of the Goods.
- vii. Except as provided in these conditions all express and implied warranties, guarantees and conditions under statute or general law as to merchantable quality, description, quality, suitability or fitness of the Goods for any purpose or as to design, assembly, installation, materials or workmanship or otherwise is expressly excluded.
- viii. The Supplier does not represent that it will provide and/or deliver any Goods unless it is included in the Quote.

12. WARRANTY

- i. The Supplier warrants to the original purchaser of all concealed hinges and/or drawer slides (but not the product itself) against all defects in material and workmanship for as long as the original purchaser owns the product.
- ii. This warranty is given to the extent permitted by law in place of all other warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.
- iii. Under this warranty, replacement of parts is the sole and exclusive remedy.
- iv. In no event shall the Supplier be liable for consequential or incidental damages or otherwise be liable to provide any indemnity for loss resulting from or contributed to be the use, installation, performance or failure of its concealed hinges or drawer slides.
- v. The warranty for Goods supplied shall be the current warranty provided by the manufacturer of the Goods. The Supplier shall not be bound by nor be responsible for any term, condition, representation or warranty other than that which is given by the manufacturer of the Goods. The Supplier will use its best endeavours to assist the Customer with any claim with respect of the Goods.

vi. The Customer agrees to be responsible for all amounts owing to the Supplier in the event that any Goods are supplied on the basis that a manufacturers warranty is in place and it subsequently becomes known to the parties that the warranty is void or inapplicable.

vii. Warranty for Goods shall only cover the cost of Goods. The Customer acknowledges that additional costs incurred, such as labour and/or freight, must be borne by the Customer.

viii. If the Customer is in default of any payment to the Supplier after a written request has been made, the warranty shall cease and the Supplier shall thereafter in no circumstances be liable under the terms of the warranty.

13. TERMINATION AND CANCELLATION

- i. **Cancellation by Supplier**
- ii. The Supplier may cancel any Order to which these Terms and Conditions apply or cancel delivery of Goods at any time before the Goods are delivered provided by giving written notice to the Customer. On giving such notice the Supplier shall repay to the Customer any sums paid in respect of the Price. The Supplier shall not be liable for any loss or damage or consequential loss or damage whatever arising from such cancellation.
- iii. Without prejudice to the Suppliers other remedies at law, the Supplier shall be entitled to cancel all or any part of any Order of the Customer which remains unfulfilled and all amounts owing to the Supplier shall, whether or not due for payment, become immediately payable in the event that: any money payable to the Supplier becomes overdue; or the Customer becomes insolvent, convenes a meeting with its creditors or proposes or enters into an arrangement with creditors, or makes an assignment for the benefit of its creditors; or a receiver, manager, liquidator (provisional or otherwise) or similar person is appointed in respect of the Customer or any asset of the Customer.
- iv. **Cancellation by Customer**
- v. Any Order cannot be cancelled by the Customer unless expressly agreed to by the Supplier in writing.
- vi. In the event that the Customer cancels delivery of Goods the Customer shall be liable for any loss incurred by the Supplier (including, but not limited to, any loss of profits) up to the time of cancellation, including a fee for the processing and acceptance of the Customers order and request for cancellation.
- vii. If the Customer places an Order with the Supplier and the Supplier places an Order with a third party Supplier to meet the Customers request, the Customer shall be liable for the Price of the Goods ordered if the Customer cancels the Order and the Goods have already been dispatched.
- viii. **Limitation of damage**
- ix. The Customer acknowledges that in the event of any breach of this Agreement/Order by the Supplier including indirect, special or consequential loss, the remedies of the Customer shall be limited to damages which under no circumstances shall exceed the Price.

14. SET-OFF

- i. The Customer shall have no right of set-off in any suit, claim or proceeding brought by the Supplier against the Customer for default in payment.
- ii. The Customer acknowledges that the Supplier can produce this clause in bar of any proceeding for set-off.

15. INSURANCE

The Customer is responsible to effect whatever insurance cover he requires at his own expense.

16. AGREED USE

- i. The Customer acknowledges that the Customer may forfeit any rights if any, he may have against the Supplier if: a) The Goods are applied for any other use to which the Goods are not intended for and/or not in accordance with any applicable instructions; b) The Customer further acknowledges sole responsibility for any damage or injury to property or person caused by using the Goods in any way, which the Customer may forfeit their rights against the Supplier.
- ii. The Customer acknowledges that they have no relied on any representation or warranty from the Supplier with respect to the merchantable quality, description, quality, suitability or fitness of the Goods.

17. JURISDICTION

This Agreement is deemed to be made in the State of Victoria and all disputes hereunder shall be determined by the appropriate courts of Victoria.

18. PRIVACY ACT 1988

- i. The Customer and/or the Guarantor's agree for the Supplier to obtain from a credit reporting agency a credit report containing personal credit information about the Customer and Guarantor's in relation to credit provided by the Supplier.
- ii. The Customer and/or the Guarantor's agree that the Supplier may exchange information about the Customer and the Guarantor's with those credit providers either named as trade referees by the Customer or named in a consumer credit report issued by a credit reporting agency for the following purposes: a) To assess an application by Customer; b) To notify other credit providers of a default by the Customer; c) To exchange information with other credit providers as to the status of this credit account, where the Customer is in default with other credit providers; d) To assess the credit worthiness of Customer and/or Guarantor's.
- iii. The Customer consents to the Supplier being given a consumer credit report to collect overdue payment on commercial credit (Section 18K (1)(b) *Privacy Act 1988*).
- iv. The Customer agrees that personal credit information provided may be used and retained by the Supplier for the following purposes and for other purposes as shall be agreed between the Customer and Supplier or required by law from time to time: a) Provision of Goods and/or Services; b) Marketing of Goods by the Supplier, its agents or distributors in relation to the Goods; c) Analysing, verifying and/or checking the Customer's credit, payment and/or status in relation to provision of Goods and/or Services; d) Processing of any payment instructions, direct debit facilities and/or credit facilities requested by Customer; e) Enabling the daily operation of Customers account and/or the collection of amounts outstanding in the Customers account in relation to the Goods and/or Services.
- v. The Supplier may give information about the Customer to a credit reporting agency for the following purposes: a) To obtain a consumer credit report about the Customer; b) Allow the credit reporting agency to create or maintain a credit information file containing information about the Customer.

19. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

- i. The Terms and Conditions set out in this Agreement constitute the whole Agreement made between the Customer and the Supplier.
- ii. This Agreement can only be amended in writing signed by each of the parties.
- iii. All prior discussions and negotiations are merged within this document and the Supplier expressly waives all prior representations made by him or on his behalf that are in conflict with any clauses in this document in any way.
- iv. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions is intended to have the effect of contravening any applicable provisions of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* or the *Fair Trading Act* in each of the States and Territories of Australia.
